### General Instructions for CV:

CV needs to be in point form and to include the following headings: Education; Paid Employment; Community Work/Volunteer Experience; Department Volunteer Experience; Awards and Recognition.

Do not include activities that all MOT students are doing like clinic visits, health mentor, IP passport, course work, and participation in Capstone presentations.
