Eligibility: MOT1 or MOT2	Four scholarships have been made available through the Vancouver Foundation by the late Myrtle Lorena Kievell in memory of her parents, James Wesley and Margaret Gardiner Kievell, and her brother, William Elder Kievell. One award is offered on the recommendation of the Faculty of Medicine to a female student entering third or fourth year in any medical field, and a second award is offered on the recommendation of the School of Nursing to a female student entering third or fourth year Nursing. One award of \$750 is offered respectively on the recommendation of the Department of Physical Therapy and the Department of Occupational Science & Occupational Therapy to a first or second year female student in PT or OT. It is hoped that award recipients will spend time in an area where medical help is very much needed – in Canada or elsewhere.
